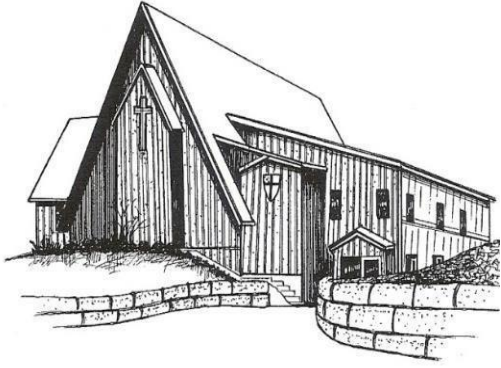

The Chaplain of the Athletic Department at Huntington University is looking for host families to help with a hospitality ministry with international student athletes. He is coordinating this effort and is in the process of contacting church leaders to arrange for host families who would be a good fit.
